### Bin 1 - Flutterby Sauvignon Blanc

*South Africa*

£16.00

This Sauvignon Blanc smacks of rich passion fruit and other tropical flavours which are well balanced by a fresh grassy edge and summer freshness is provided by a crisp acidity.

### Bin 3 – Malle Point Chardonnay

*Australia*

£16.00

This Chardonnay flaunts aromas of fresh tropical fruit with touches of coconut and vanilla oak. It shows hints of peach and melon and is smooth and easy to drink.

## Red

### Bin 4 - Santa Gloria Merlot

*Chile*

£16.00

A brilliant wine that ticks all the boxes! Dripping with bright damson fruit and a lovely silky mouthfeel, this is what Merlot is all about, but which is often very difficult to find. Especially at this silly price.... Chilean Winery of the year at London Wine Show.

### Bin 5 – Mallee Point Shiraz

*Australia*

£16.00

Light and snappy, with pretty cherry and herb flavours, followed by a silky finish

## Rosé

### Bin 6 - Feather Falls Californian Zinfandel Rose

*USA*

£16.00

This is a medium fruity & flavoursome Rose with a fresh tingly aftertaste that invites you back for more....

## White Wine Selection

- Bin 8 - San Vitto Pinot Grigio** *Italy* £16.00  
Straw yellow with attractive bouquet of orange blossom and herby fruit.
- Bin 12 - Martin Wassmer Muller Thurgau** *Germany* £20.00  
Has a taste of wild flowers & herbs mixed with a fresh citrus aroma. The taste finished with an abundance of grapefruit and grapes.
- Bin 14 - Fairhall Cliffs Sauvignon Blanc** *New Zealand* £22.00  
This vineyard was planted in 1974 by John Marris and is officially the oldest surviving vineyard in Marlborough. These old vines start to give wines with more mineral characteristics – like Sancerre only on steroids.
- Bin 16 - Russbach Riesling** *Germany* £25.00  
This is seriously good stuff – lemon and lime jostle with passion fruit, apple and elderflower – all dancing on your tongue. 3<sup>rd</sup> best Riesling in Germany.
- Bin 17 - Sancerre Tradition by JP Mollet** *France* £26.00  
The world's best Sauvignon Blanc is still made in the Loire as this beautiful wine illustrates. No bells and whistles, just pure lime fruit with a nice vegetal, green herb touch. As with all of the very best French wines the key words are elegance and restraint. A really lovely glass...
- Bin 18 - Chablis Pascal Bouchard "Le Classique"** *France* £27.00  
A generous wine with excellent mineral characteristics. Made from a careful blending, this is truly the wine style of Pascal Bouchard. Our low yielding vines average between 30 and 40 years of age have deep roots that help produce a high-class wine; fat, concentrated with mineral notes. This is an intense and racy wine.

## Red Wine Selection

### Bin 21 - Novocento Malbec

*Argentina*

£17.50

A young, fruity Malbec, showing plum and blackberry. Velvety texture with tons of fruit on the palate.

### Bin 24 - Lapostolle Grand Selection Cabernet

*Chile*

£22.00

Just about the juiciest, ripest Cabernet Sauvignon we've got! No messing about with restraint and elegance here, just unashamed, up front fruit wrapped in ultra soft tannins. They say that red wine is good for the heart – well apparently Chilean Cabernet is the best of all.

### Bin 26 - Cuna de Reyes Rioja Crianza

*Spain*

£24.00

Bursting with ripe fruit aromas and tones of toasted oak and vanilla. Delicious, round, nutty palate with a subtle vanilla-berry finish.

### Bin 27 - Farina Ripasso

*Italy*

£27.00

A striking wine with hints of dried Morello cherries, herby fruit and coffee integrated with a distinct hit of spice. Incredibly smooth and complex.

### Bin 28 – Paul Jaboulet Cotes du Rhone Red

*France*

£25.00

Northern Style Cotes du Rhone, with beautiful fresh Syrah character. Notes of wild berries, white pepper, lavender and cherries. This balanced red finishes with incredibly juicy Grenache love.

### Bin 31 – Le Vaux St. George Pinot Noir

*France*

£26.00

Guy Allion's Pinot Noir is a great example from the Loire Valley. Made from biodynamically grown grapes, the wine is unoaked and delightfully fresh. Aromas of sweet berry fruit and floral notes.

## Sparkling

### Bin 35 - Borgo Magredo Prosecco

*Italy*

£24.50

Prosecco is the sparkling wine for those who think they don't like sparkling wine! Racy, sparky, funky frolics, from your head down to your...toes. Expect savoury lemon sherbet and pear drop fruit and ultra-refreshment!

### Bin 36 - Duval Leroy Brut N.V.

*France*

£49.00

France's favourite Champagne – there are more famous names but very, very few can match the quality of this stunning fizz. Unusually for Champagne, Carole Duval-Leroy's family owns all their own vineyards and management is strict, resulting in sensational quality. Only champagne to be in the wine spectator top 100 and this is listed in 23 three star Michelin restaurants in France.

### Bin 83 – Moët & Chandon

*France*

£48.00

Moët & Chandon, or Moët, is a French fine winery and co-owner of the luxury goods company LVMH Moët Hennessy Louis Vuitton SE. Moët et Chandon is one of the world's largest champagne producers and a prominent champagne house.

## Dessert

### Niepoort Ruby (35ml)

*Portugal*

£2.90

A real eye opener in that it is one of the only Ruby's around that is genuinely barrel aged. So the flavour is mellow and chocolately, with the added benefit of length and persistence. A worthy "drinking Port"

### Niepoort Tawny (35ml)

*Portugal*

£2.90

Interesting earthy, floral and fruity notes, medium-bodied, lightly sweet, adding a fruity, ironlike, earthy finish." Wine Spectator

### Niepoort LBV (35ml)

*Portugal*

£2.90
